Grace Kelly holds a very special place in the hearts and minds of the people of Newport, County Mayo. The paternal grandfather of the late Hollywood star and Princess, John Peter Kelly, hailed from Drimurla near Newport. He emigrated to Philadelphia in 1887, where he founded one of the city's leading construction companies ('Kelly for Bricks') and made his family's fortune.

Grace's path through life eventually brought her back as royalty to the Newport area in 1961, accompanied by her husband, Prince Rainier Grimaldi III of Monaco. During a number of visits to Newport in the 1960s and 1970s, she became familiar with the birthplace of her forebears and even purchased the family homestead. Many people fondly remember meeting Princess Grace during these visits.

In September 2014, Newport is proud to honour Grace Kelly, film star and H.S.H Princess Grace of Monaco with its second film festival dedicated to her memory.
